READ TOGETHER EVERY DAY

- Make reading together a regular part of your routine at home.
- Allow your child to choose books that fit their interests.
- Use drama to keep the story lively - dramatic pauses, sound effects, and expressive reading - model what good readers do
- Ask questions and encourage your child to share their wonderings.

CREATE A READING-RICH ENVIRONMENT

- develop critical thinking skills
- boost confidence in speaking and listening

CREATE A PRINT RICH ENVIRONMENT

- Make books easily accessible
- Share print materials with your child, e.g.: grocery lists, food boxes,
- Label items
- Point out print or text outside of the home e.g.: signs, menus store names

ENCOURAGE WRITING FOR REAL PURPOSES

- encourage your child to engage in meaningful writing that has a purpose and a real audience.
- provide feedback and respond to the writing

GO OUT INTO THE COMMUNITY

- visit the library and/or museum
- participate in community events such as story time,
- engage in everyday learning opportunities like reading environmental print during walks or errands.

ENGAGE IN CONVERSATIONS

Show your child you care about their ideas and opinions:

- make eye contact
- don't interrupt
- be patient
- smile, nod your head and show you are interested
